Description	<p>The Overseas Research Students Awards Scheme (ORS) grants awards on a competitive basis for partial remission of tuition fees to international postgraduate research students of outstanding merit and research potential to study in the UK. The only criteria for the awards are outstanding merit and research potential; other factors, such as financial status, ethnicity, nationality, gender, age, proposed field and institution of study will not be taken into account. New awards under the Overseas Research Students Awards Scheme (ORS) will likely be between 800 and 850 each year. The awards are tenable at specified academic institutions in the UK. The scheme is administered by Universities UK.</p>
Award	<p>Awards made will in most cases cover the difference between the tuition fee for a home (ie UK) postgraduate student and the rate charged by the institution to an international postgraduate student for the particular full-time research course being taken by the awardholder. In those cases in which the value of the award does not represent the full fee differential, the institution concerned will confirm to the student the actual rate of award which will be payable and whether he/she would incur any additional tuition fee liability. Payment of the award is made to the institution: no money will be paid direct to the awardholder. Further details and application forms should be obtained from the Registrar or Secretary of the academic institutions listed where the research is to be undertaken.</p>
